High School Bible

Mr. Schwartz: 9th and 10th (boys only), 11th, and 12th

- Bible—Most memory verses will be from NIV and wording will be provided in class. NIV will also be used for wording used on test questions. However, students may choose any translation they wish to study from.
- Loose leaf paper in a binder or folder
- Highlighter(s) and colored pencils
- Tissues for class supply

Mrs. Black: 9th and 10th (girls only)

- Bible—preferably NIV or Standard Version
- Loose leaf paper in a binder
- 2 tab dividers

High School Science (Mrs. Taylor)

- 3-ring Notebook (at least 1.5-2 inch) *Dedicated to science only!*
- College Ruled Loose Leaf Notebook Paper
- 5 pack Tab Dividers
- Black Ink Pen

- Highlighter (Your choice of color)
- **Physical Science (9th), Chemistry (10th), and Physics (12th):** calculator
 - *the one you use for math class is fine*
- **Biology (11th):** colored pencils
- Suggested: Pencil pocket for your notebook
- One item for class use: tissues, white board markers, or sanitizing wipes
- *Additional materials may be requested during the course for projects and labs.*

High School Language Arts (Ms. Spears)

- 3-ring binder with pockets (1" is sufficient)
- 5 tab dividers
- College ruled loose leaf paper (*no spiral notebooks, please*)
- Pencils with erasers
- Black pen
- Optional but recommended: a large 3-ring pencil pouch for your binder
- **For extra credit:** one item for classroom use (e.g. sanitizing wipes, tissue, paper towels, or stationery cards with envelopes, preferably thank you or blank)

High School Math

- 3-ring binder (2" preferred)

- Scientific Calculator
 - *The TI-84 graphing calculator will be very useful in class, on the ACT, and in subsequent high school and college courses. For a less expensive option, the Casio fx-300ES Plus or the TI-30XS MultiView are also good calculators that are approved for the ACT.
