2026-2027 Middle School Supply List

All students need to bring:

- 1) **wired non-bluetooth earbuds/headphones to use with Chromebooks for all classes. No wireless bluetooth earbuds allowed.**
- 2) **a minimum of one ream of copy paper**
- 3) **2 boxes of tissues**
- 4) **1 plastic folder with pockets (This will be used for a daily “Take Home” folder to keep students from bringing home so many binders each day.)**
- 5) **Colored pencils**

Supplies needed by grade level:

Math

- High quality 5 Subject spiral notebook (example: 5-subject Mead)
- 3-ring binder with inside pockets (1" works well - separate from other classes) (filled with paper)
- 1 pack of unopened loose leaf paper (wide ruled) for classroom
- 1 pack hole-punched graph paper (for classroom)
- 2 tab dividers for math binder
- Pencils (of any type, mechanical pencils or wooden - no pens allowed for daily work)
- 2 highlighters (different colors)
- 6th/7th grade: Basic calculator
- 8th grade: Scientific calculator (Casio fx-300ES Plus, or TI-30XS MultiView, or a TI-84)
- Ruler and Protractor (to keep at home)

Language:

- 2 packets of unopened loose leaf college ruled notebook paper for the classroom
 - 5 tab dividers
 - 3 ring binder (1.5-2" works well, separate from other classes)
 - College ruled composition notebook (80 pages or more, standard size - no spiral bound)
 - Pencils (mechanical or wooden - no pens or erasable pen for daily work)*
 - 2 Red ink pens for editing*
 - 4 Highlighters of different colors (pink, yellow, green, and blue at least)*
- * We use these materials consistently, so they may need to be replenished throughout the year.*

Science:

- 1 inch, 3 ring binder (separate from other classes)
- Pencils, pens, highlighters
- 3 tab dividers
- \$5.00 lab fee

History:

- 1 inch, 3 ring binder (separate from other classes)
- College ruled composition notebook (100 pages or more, standard size - no spiral bound)
- Loose leaf paper
- Pencils, pens, highlighters
- 3 tab dividers

Class Rotations - Exact Path / Computer / Chorus-Music: (combined in one binder)

- 1 white 1-inch binder
- 1 pack clear page protectors
- 3 tab dividers
